The MN CD E&T Project builds upon the fact that both at NATO and Allied nations levels, Education and Training (E&T) perform a central role in the development, operation and maintenance of skills and competencies associated with Cyber Defence Capabilities. The aim of this project is to create a CD E&T Coordination Platform (central coordination point for a web of E&T activities) and to provide new initiatives to fulfill Nations' and NATO's CD E&T shortfalls.
2. Allied military & civilian staffs, national authorities, NATO bodies and external stakeholders are invited to attend the **Multinational Cyber Defense Education and Training Project Workshop #8**, to be held in Lisbon (Portugal), **27 April 2016**. The meeting will take place at the Portuguese Military Academy, Amadora. The deadline for signing up will be Friday, **15 April 2016**.
3. On the **26<sup>th</sup> April 2016** a pre-meeting workshop will take place at the Portuguese Military Academy (Academia Militar) organized by WP01#02, WP01#03 and WP01#04.
4. The purpose of this workshop is to further discuss and approve phase 1 (CD Competencies & Skills) results, its integration at phase 2 (CD Training Requirements Analysis) and to approve the updated version of phase 2 and phase 3 pilot questionnaires. A new update of the Common CD E&T Curriculum will be presented and discussed. Academia representatives are invited in order to further define the implementation plan of WP05#01 (Cyber Security and Cyber Defence International Master) and WP05#02 (Cyber Law and Cyber Defence Master).

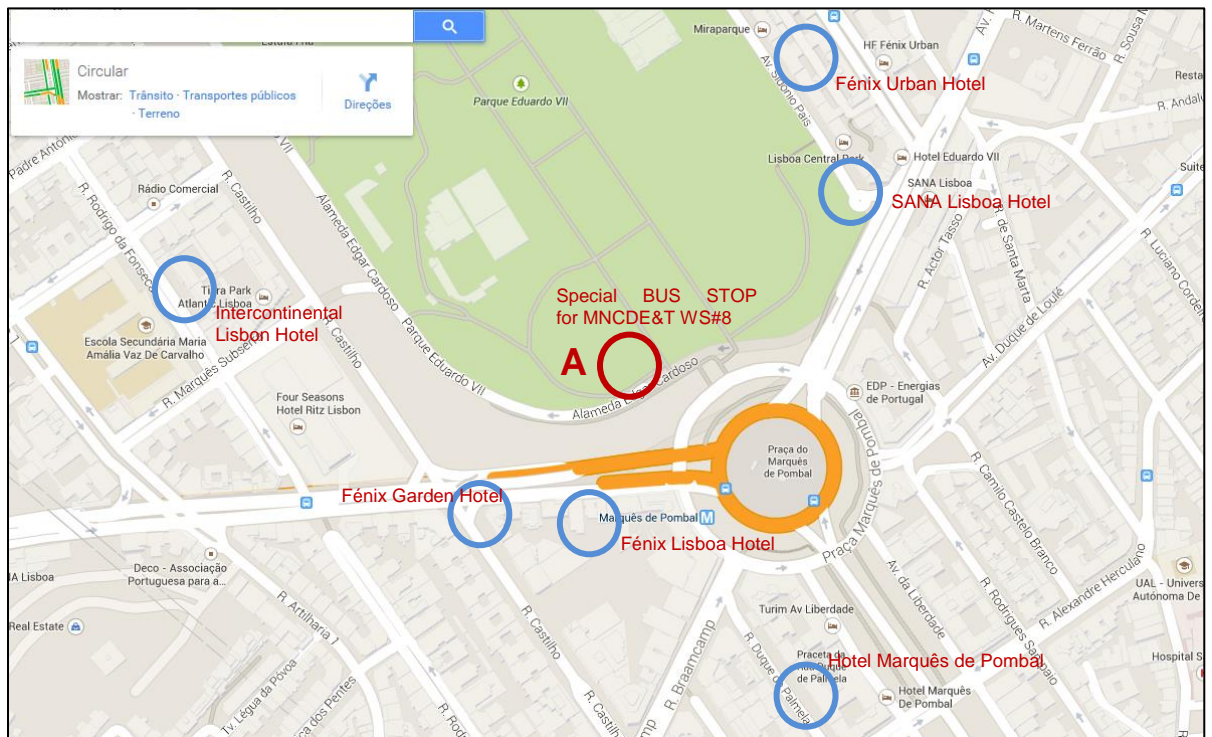


Figure 1 – Map of the recommended hotels' area
